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**Scheduling:**

The Play & Train program is designed to build a strong foundation for good manners and behavior in your dog. In order to accomplish this, the program must be completed within a 2-3 week time period, unless otherwise cleared with the trainer. Additionally, all sessions **MUST** be scheduled in advance; no drop-in sessions will be accepted.

**Owner Meeting:**

At the conclusion of the Play & Train program, the owner and the trainer will set up an appointment for the owner to receive feedback and notes, take part in a demonstration of your dog's progress, and ask any questions that he or she may have. This meeting typically lasts around 30 minutes and needs to be arranged in advance. Owner meetings are not available until the final session is complete, though some brief updates may be provided upon request.

**Gear & Supplies:**

The owner doesn't need to bring any special gear with the dog to be able to complete a Play & Train program, apart from a leash to enter the building. However, if the dog has any dietary restrictions or allergies, it may be in his or her best interest to provide food or treats that are appropriate and safe for him or her to consume.

Throughout the program, the trainer may find that certain tools are helpful for the pet, and she will pass along that information in the owner meeting.

**Results & Support:**

No dog can be fully trained in a matter of a few hours. The dog will leave his final session with new skills that will likely need to be further polished and developed beyond the scope of the Play & Train program. Making the most of the investment requires commitment on the owner's end to maintain the training and prevent the dog from backsliding to former behaviors.

The transition to training at home after a Play & Train program takes time. The trainer puts in a lot of effort to connect with, understand, and communicate with the dog during the sessions. In order to see the same results at home that the trainer gets on site, the owner must reflect that same level of commitment and patience at home. The trainer is available for support following the program to make this transition as smooth as possible and to assist in obstacles that pop up along the way.
